| ✓ Drywall & plaster (no lead paint) | ✓ Fencing, posts & railings |
| ✓ Wood scraps, lumber & framing | ✓ Insulation — fiberglass batts (non-asbestos) |
| ✓ Cabinets, countertops & millwork | ✓ Bathroom fixtures — tubs, toilets, sinks |
| ✓ Flooring — tile, laminate, hardwood, vinyl | ✓ Roofing shingles — asphalt (bagged preferred) |
| ✓ Carpet & carpet pad | ✓ Siding — vinyl, wood, fiber cement |
| ✓ Windows & doors (glass removed or wrapped) | ✓ Decking boards & lattice |
| ✓ Metal framing, pipes & conduit | ✓ Scaffolding boards & plywood |
| ✓ Wire, copper & scrap metal | ✓ Non-hazardous construction packaging |

| ✗ Lead paint drywall or confirmed lead materials | ✗ Concrete/Brick — See our Heavy Load Guide |
| ✗ Liquid paint, solvents & job site chemicals | ✗ Asphalt — See our Heavy Load Guide |
| ✗ Treated Wood (If unsure call or send photo) | ✗ Dirt/Fill Material — See our Heavy Load Guide |

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Do not overfill above the bin rim — illegal to transport
- Prohibited items may result in extra fees or refused pickup
- Asbestos is NEVER accepted — requires certified disposal
- Bag shingles when possible to help manage weight limits
